ART for Kids is an educational experience sponsored by the Cincinnati Art Club. Art for Kids is an educational program that provides advanced instruction for Cincinnati Public School students who have strong artistic skills. Your CPS teachers believe this 6-week program will prepare students to achieve more when they return to school in the Fall.

This is an all-day art program, for 6 weeks, each Tuesday. The first class is on June 6. Classes will be held at the Cincinnati Art Club teaching facility at 1021 Parkside Place, located at the bottom of Mt. Adams and the rear entrance to Eden Park. Classes begin promptly at 9:00 in the morning and students can be picked up by parents at 3:00 in the afternoon. The building will be closed at 3:15 so pickup time must be adhered. The classes will be held each Tuesday on June 6, 13, 20, and 27 and on July 11 & 18

The lead teacher is Marin McFadden. Marin has a BS and MA in Art Education K-12 from Miami University. Ten years of teaching elementary students in public schools. Marilyn Bartos is the Assistant Art Teacher. She brings extensive experience in teaching art. She led a class at the Art Guild at Fairfield Glade and taught home school students. Both Marin and Marilyn are Associate Members of the Cincinnati Art Club. Class projects will help students to learn about historically famous artists as well as the seven principles of art.

- This is a 6-week art experience, meeting 6 hours a day from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM. We will break occasionally for exercise and time to make new friends.

PICK UP TIME IS PROMPTLY AT 3:00. Please be on-time.

The teachers will leave at 3:15. If you have an emergency, call us no later than 1:00.

- The classes will be held each Tuesday on June 6, 13, 20, and 27 and on July 11 & 18.
- A light lunch with bottled water will be provided, but students with food allergies should bring their own lunch.
- All art supplies for each project will be provided by the Cincinnati Art Club..
- We will teach about famous artists and the seven principles of art. Famous artists include Jim Dine, Georgia O'Keefe, Alberto Giacometti, Pablo Picasso, and Jacob Lawrence, among others. The Principles of Art include Color, Line, Value, Form, Texture Space, and Shape.
- A Class Monitor will be on staff to assist the teachers and help aid the security of students while at the Club. • We will contact you for any emergency at the phone numbers you provide to us..
- Rules for behavior will be the same as in school.
